

Kindness Challenge 2025- Clare Luther School visit (1st prize) and set of Clare Luther books (2nd prize).

1. This prize draw is open to residents of England who are aged 18 and over but excludes employees of the NSPCC, and companies or persons associated with the NSPCC, and/or the draw (including immediate family members). The draw is free to enter and no donation or payment is necessary
2. Nurseries and Schools that register to take part in the NSPCC Kindness Challenge excluding schools and nurseries in Scotland, Wales, Northern Ireland and the Channel Islands for logistical reasons, will automatically be entered into the free prize draw to win a visit from Clare Luther at that nursery/ school OR A SET OF Clare Luther books. To enter without registering to take part in the Kindness Challenge, the nursery or school should send a note by post containing its full name, address, phone number and email address, in a sealed envelope to KINDNESS CHALLENGE PRIZE DRAW, NATIONAL TRAINING CENTRE 3 GILMOUR CLOSE, LEICESTER, LE4 1EZ.
3. The prize draw shall be open from 13/06/2025 and will close on 15/09/25. All entries received before or after these times will not be included in the prize draw. Any entries that are incomplete, incomprehensible or not received will be void. One prize winner will be selected randomly by the NSPCC from all qualifying entries on 15/09/25. If the selected winner cannot be contacted or does not respond within 3 working days of being notified by the NSPCC, or if the selected winner cannot take the prize between 6th October-10th October, or if any of the conditions of taking the prize are not fulfilled (see below), then the NSPCC reserves the right to select an alternative winner. The winner will be notified via email or telephone.
4. The first prize is a visit to the winning school or nursery from Clare Luther between 06/10/25-10/10/25 at a time to be agreed between the winning school or nursery and Clare Luther. The prize is conditional on (a) the winning school or nursery consenting to Clare Luther visiting the school or nursery between 06/10/25-10/10/25. The second prize is a set of Clare Luther books.
5. The prize will be supplied by Clare Luther. Clare Luther reserves the right to change the prize due to circumstances beyond its control and/or to offer an alternative prize of similar value. There is no cash equivalent or alternative for the prize and the prize is non-transferable, non-exchangeable and cannot be resold.
